



About the 8th International Capacity Building Program of Green Crescent

The 8th International Capacity Building Program of Green Crescent is organized by the International Federation of Green Crescent (IFGC) hosted by the Turkish Green Crescent Society, and supported by contributing sponsors.

This year's program brings together representatives of the Green Crescent family from around the world for a meaningful in-person gathering. It serves as a continuation of our shared efforts to strengthen prevention, recovery, and advocacy practices worldwide.

In recent years, both the Capacity Building Programs and the online trainings organized under the umbrella of the IFGC have aimed to build a shared foundation of knowledge and to strengthen collaboration between local and global experts. Building on that foundation, this year's event shifts the focus toward **regional and national needs**, with an emphasis on **achievable**, **action-oriented outcomes**.

The three-day program includes:

- Presentations from international experts and Green Crescent
- representatives
- Interactive training sessions
- Discussion groups aimed at collaboration and strategy-building

Sessions in the **Main Hall** will be delivered with **simultaneous interpretation in French and Turkish.** Sessions in the **parallel Meeting Rooms** will be conducted **in English only.**
